

Reading Double Line Graphs

How do you read a double line graph?

Line graphs can help you interpret and analyze data. They can also help you compare more than one set of data. Look at the double line graph below. It shows the growth patterns of two plants during an investigation. Notice the key in the upper left corner of the graph. The key explains how the data for each plant are shown.
